SECOND DIRECTION OF THE PRESIDENT

In the matter of claims brought against HMV Group plc, HMV UK Limited and Fopp Entertainments Limited (in administration) involving unfair dismissal, breach of contract and protective awards as a result of failure to consult over a redundancy situation

IN THE MATTER of claims submitted in different regions of the Employment Tribunals in England and Wales arising from the administration of HMV Group plc, HMV UK Limited and Fopp Entertainments Limited.

AND having made a Direction on 27 March 2013 staying all claims in their respective regions until further notice.

AND having noted that the names of the HMV companies have been changed as follows;

- i) Record Shop 1 Limited (in administration) formerly HMV UK Limited
- ii) Record Shop 2 Limited (in administration) formerly HMV Music Limited
- iii) Record Shop 3 Limited (in administration) formerly HMV (IP) Limited
- iv) Record Shop 4 Limited (in administration) formerly Fopp Entertainments Limited

AND upon consideration of representations received from Deloitte LLP by letter dated 2 May 2013, advising that a number of claims involving the administration of HMV have identified Deloitte LLP as a Respondent in proceedings.

AND having regard to the overriding objective under Regulation 3 of the Employment Tribunals (Constitution and Rules of Procedure) Regulations 2004.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. All current claims and any additional claims in England & Wales identifying Deloitte LLP as a Respondent which raise the same or similar issues as those brought against the HMV group of companies, be subject to the same stay as Ordered in the Direction signed on 27 March 2013.
2. Any party or representative wishing to make representations for the further conduct of these claims should do so upon application to the President.
