CASE MANAGEMENT ORDER OF THE PRESIDENT

In the matter of claims brought against Game Stores Group Ltd (in administration) involving claims relating to protective awards and related matters

1. Games Stores Group Ltd (in administration)

RESPONDENTS

Claims against the Respondent raising claims relating to protective awards and related matters were subject to a Direction of the President dated 17 March 2014, transferring all claims to the Birmingham Employment Tribunal and staying those claims pending the outcome of *Lyttle and others v Bluebird UK Bidco and USDAW v Ethel Austin Ltd* (in administration) in the Court of Justice of the European Union

AND having regard to the overriding objective under Rule 2 of the first schedule to the Employment Tribunals (Constitution and Rules of Procedure) Regulations 2013.

AND having now received the Judgment of the CJEU dated 30 April 2015.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The stay be lifted in all claims in England & Wales raising the same or similar issues that were stayed by the Direction of the President signed 17 March 2014.
2. And it is further Ordered that these claims be transferred to Birmingham Employment Tribunal for the Regional Employment Judge to give directions for the consideration and expeditious disposal of the claims.
3. Any party or representative wishing to make representations for the further conduct of these claims should do so upon application to the Regional Employment Judge of the Midlands (West) region.
