1. On the 21st August 2015 this court committed the following named person to prison

Miss Alicia Brar

2. in relation to an order dated 22nd June 2015 which provided that the Defendant should not

- i) enter or be in any part of Southall, except the area consisting of the Lady Margaret Ward.
- ii) engage or threaten to engage in any conduct capable of causing nuisance or annoyance or which is likely to cause harassment, alarm or distress (whether by herself or by instructing or encouraging any other person) to any person residing at any premises or any person visiting residents at those premises or any person employed (whether or not by the Council (London Borough of Ealing)) in connection with the Council's housing management functions

3. The Court found that following admissions made by her that she had disobeyed/breached that order by

- i) being present in Manor House Grounds which is a park in Southall at or around 13.00 hours in breach of paragraph (a) of the said Order; and
- ii being present in Manor House Grounds which is a park in Southall at or around 18.50 hours in breach of paragraph (a) of the said Order; and
- iii being present at 22 Blandford Road Southall which is in Southall in breach of paragraph (a) of the said Order; and
- iv banging on the door at 22 Blandford Road Southall and shouting in breach of paragraph (b) of the said Order

and imposed the following sentences for those breaches

i) 28 days imprisonment with regard to 3.i to 3.iv (inclusive) each sentence to run concurrently with regard to each breach

4. Accordingly it was ordered that Alicia Brar be committed for contempt to prison for a total period of 28 days The order is suspended until 20th February 2016 and will not be put into force if during that time Miss Alicia Brar complies with the terms: of the Order of 22nd June 2015

1. On the 24th August 2015 this court committed the following named person to prison

Miss Alicia Brar

in relation to an order dated 22nd June 2015 which provided that the Defendant should not enter or be in any part of Southall, except the area consisting of the Lady Margaret Ward.

3. The Court found that, following admissions made by her, that she had disobeyed/breached the order of 22nd June 2015 by

- i) being present in Regina Road Southall in or around 17.50 p.m. on 22nd August 2015 in breach of paragraph (a) of the said Order

and imposed the following sentence for that breach and also sentenced her for the breach of four suspended sentences imposed for the breach of the same said Order on 20th August 2015 namely

- i) 28 days imprisonment with regard to 3.i
- ii) 28 days imprisonment with regard to her breaches of the suspended sentences the sentences at 3i and 3ii to run concurrently (total 56 days).
